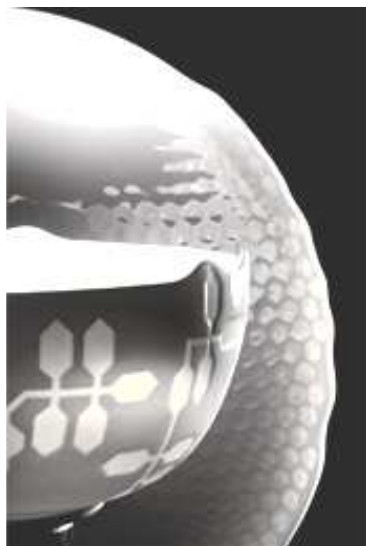
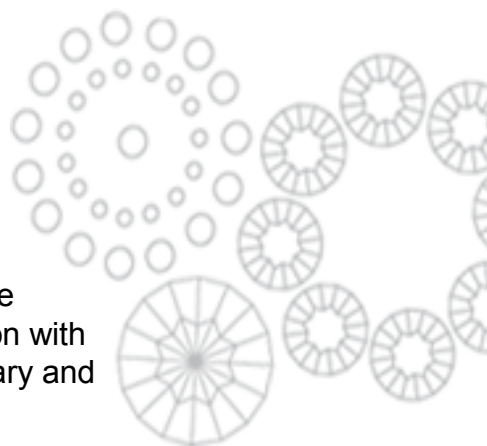


'Landscape'

Rosenthal studio-line 'Landscape' has been created by renowned Spanish designer Patricia Urquiola, acclaimed for her designs which combine slick, contemporary looks and traditional Spanish crafts. Born in Spain, Patricia now resides in the design capital of the world, Milan Italy, where she has developed a solid reputation in the fields of exhibition, furniture and homewares design and has worked with leading brands including Moroso, B&B Italia, Alessi and Bossa.



With the Rosenthal studio-line 'Landscape' collection Patricia has allowed herself to move to a tactile, delicate and subtle place where paper-thin porcelain highlights three-dimension patterns on organic shapes. Softness and beauty evoke the senses while a play of light creates drama and atmosphere through the transparent windows of the pieces.

Presented in purest white, this tableware range comes to life with touch, and each piece tells a story of intimacy and playfulness. Unexpected shapes are married with delicate design details bringing to life natural landscapes in a modern frame with unexpected whimsical edging and the finest embossed finishing.



Patricia Urquiola's design combines western tabletop culture with the oriental tradition of spontaneous and versatile tableware usage. The collection includes plates of various sizes, a tea story, accessory pieces and the most delightful bowls.
